PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS



Ohio Turnpike and Infrastructure Commission (OTIC): Tolls Operations Support & Advisory Services (Prime: Acumen)

OTIC is carrying out a multi-year modernization program to enhance operations, increase efficiency and improve customer service. Recently, the agency completed implementation of a new roadside toll-collection system and commercial back-office system. Acumen is providing professional toll system support services and advisory expertise to update and enhance OTIC's existing Toll Operations Manual to reflect current operations, best practices and align with the agency's vision for the future.





Santa Clara Valley Transportation Authority (VTA): BART Silicon Valley Phase II Extension Project

VTA's BART Silicon Valley Phase II Extension (BSVII) Project is a six-mile, four-station extension of the regional BART system from Berryessa/North through downtown San Jose to the City of Santa Clara, serving 55,000 weekday riders. The BSVII Project includes three underground station platforms, one ground-level station, and a new maintenance and storage facility. Acumen will provide construction inspection services.



Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC): Local Public Fleet Electrification Planning Technical Assistance

This MTC Public Fleet Electrification Planning Assistance Program provides local public agencies with consultant assistance for public fleet electrification planning, such as assessing fleets, fleet replacement options, fueling and charging needs, infrastructure siting, costs and impacts, and transition actions. Acumen technical support includes a Data Collection, Operations and Management (O&M) Plan and grant support.
